Stitch count: Approx. 100 x 100

1. 12" x 12" Soft Ivory 18 mono canvas
2. Number 22, 24 and beading needles

6. Bugle Beads – Lt Green 12 mm twisted - 32

## Instructions

7. Attach the canvas to stretcher bars with tacks or staples. For best results I find that the surface of the canvas that is "in the well", should be worked. This is the front of the finished piece. This means that the flat side of the canvas, when stretched onto the bars, will be the back of the finished piece. This will keep your design cleaner, more **protected**, and will make starting and ending threads much easier.
