

## Playing with Trianglepoint by Marcy Brown

### Supplies List

#### Ground:

- For notebook samples, a 12 x 12 #18 canvas, color of your choice. 12 x 12 gives enough room for multiple samples.
- If you want to stitch the entire Mosaic Sampler Pillow as a pillow rather than as individual stitch samples, the design size is approximately. 10.5 x 12 so you'll want a 16 x 18 canvas.
- If you plan to stitch the mini-stockings, check the magazine for details.

#### Thread:

For ease of stitching while learning the patterns, a non-stranded thread in your fiber of choice is recommended.

- Pepper Pot or Vineyard Silk Classic
- Pearl cotton 5
- Waverly Wool or Colonial Persian (you'll use a single strand)
- Or any other threads from your stash!
- If you use a stranded cotton or silk, you'll use the number of strands that you would normally use for straight stitches on #18 canvas and will need a laying tool.

If you're stitching notebook samples, you'll likely want at least three colors: a light, medium, and dark value of any color scheme of your choosing (monochrome, analogous, complementary, etc.).

If you want to do the pillow as presented in the book, you'll need five colors: light, medium, dark, very dark, and white.
